# requirements

And finally, the most important requirement: this is not an organised party. Forget all those things about New Year's Eve. You will not know what you're going to do every minute of the day. Everything is improvised. Everything will come naturally. We DO NOT organise anything. Things just happen. Trust us - it works! The only thing you'll have to do is participate with positive feelings, and the magic will do all the work!

## accommodation

At <u>www.hostelworld.com</u> you can find a bit of everything. But **PAY ATTENTION:** do not panic if this page or the page of another hostel tells you that they have no available rooms, they may only offer a percentage of their available rooms on the internet. This means that if you call them and tell them that you're going there, you'll (usually) have no problems. Obviously, don't wait until December to do that (also for the flights). Remember: first come, first served.

We are going to stay at the **Hans Brinker** (<a href="www.hans-brinker.com">www.hans-brinker.com</a>). That was our first choice five years ago and most of us were in the same place. Nobody regretted it! (It's a very special place.) **IMPORTANT**: this hostel organizes a party on the 31st of December and you must pay for it if you're staying there (€50). The party was amazing! It starts at 17:00 and you can eat and drink all you want. It's not necessary to stay there all night, but it is a good starting point (and/or end-point... ⊕ )

**Prices** at the Hans Brinker Hotel for this New Year's Eve: a single-room is €53.50 per person per night. A double room is €36.50 per person per night. A room with three beds is €31.50 per person per night. Rooms with 4 and 5 beds are €25.50 per person per night. Rooms with 6 and 8 beds are €22.50 per person per night. It seems that the 8 bed rooms are already full. For this reason we highly recommend you not to wait - make a reservation as soon as possible! **IMPORTANT**: as this is high season, there is a minimum booking period of 3 nights.

It's very easy to make a reservation in the heaven called Hans Brinker: call or write to <a href="mailto:sybil@hans-brinker.net">sybil@hans-brinker.net</a>.

When booking, use the keyword "PETAKA" (which means "hipflask" in Spanish) in your call or email as this will help us to stay together in the same rooms with other PETAKIANOS (or hipflaskers ©).

## how to...

When you receive this email, just **forward it to all the friends** you think would like to join the event. Then write and tell us you want to join. So you to know how the situation is evolving, we'll send you an email every week giving you news about the event and the number of people who have already joined. After this step, we'll make a mailing list of all the people who have joined up and we'll write among ourselves. But we'll add all those people later.

## Two simple rules:

- Confirm your attendance only when you've booked your flight.
